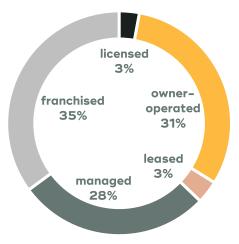

- > Increasing alignment across investors, developers, operators, and construction contractors in pursuit of ESG goals and property preparedness - sustainable building practices and early investment towards weather proofing.
- > Hospitality revenue streams have increased in scope with the rising prevalence of club membership programs and serviced living – two areas that have witnessed an uptick in activity throughout the Covid-19 pandemic with demand coming from locals and foreigners.
- > The Caribbean submarket continues to lead the country in terms of room demand and pipeline projects.
- > The Baja California submarket, including Cabo San Lucas, leads the country with highest ADR.
- > Over the course of the past two decades, foreign direct investment in tourism in Mexico has totaled about \$24 billion, and branded residences and serviced living took the largest amount at 61% or \$14.6 billion.
