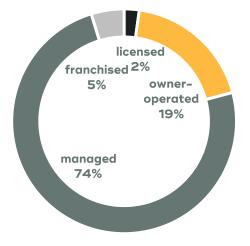

- Nigeria is again the best performing African market with 47% occupancy ytd 2021 according to STR reports.
- Business is mainly driven by domestic demand of the corporate and government sector.
- Notable are the recent openings of hotels in Lagos which is seen as a sign of the resilience of the market.
- > The 196+ barometer:
 - however, points towards a leisure led recovery for 52% of respondents
 - as far as the pipeline is concerned the roundtable participants felt that delays of one year or longer are expected
 - > 50% felt that a return to 2019 levels may happen as soon as 2023
 - Like in most other markets the resilient serviced apartment sector is expected to see the strongest growth in the next 3 to 5 years
